
IXMLembedder general process

1. Make backup copy of client files.









2. Set up each IXMLembedder project to capture information to appropriately identify client files, the client file type, and the file sequence order.

3. Document IDs serve as maps/locators that pinpoint the location for embedding index entries.




a. Insert document IDs into the client files.



 Index in CINDEX or Sky, using document IDs as page locator substitutes.

4. Save updated client files (containing the document IDs) as XML files.









6. Run IXMLembedder to create new XML files with embedded entries.















8. Clean up unused document IDs (not necessary for XML projects). Prepare files for client by saving embedded files in desired client format.
